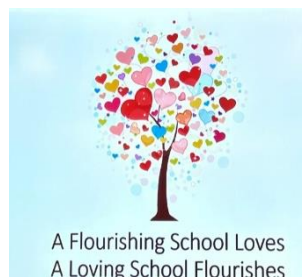

FRIENDLY REMINDERS

DINNER MONEY


