Priorities for pupils	How catch up funding will be spent (including costings)	How the impact of this will be measured
Addressing gaps in phonics (Y1 to Y3)	Phonics tracker (£225) online resource TA booster groups	Increase in attainment at Summer phonics check for pupils in Y1 and Y2 (compared to autumn results). Reduction in gaps identified by phonics tracker.
Narrowing gaps in learning- especially English and maths	Supply teacher employed to deliver catch-up/intervention sessions three days per week. Class teachers assess pupils and determine which children will benefit from catch-up lessons. (£12,000)	Judgement of teachers through formative and summative assessments. End of year assessment data. Class teachers monitor impact of sessions.
Addressing gaps in foundation subjects due to school closure.	CPD for subject leaders so they can receive advice on this at clusters/from consultants (£1000)	Subject leaders' monitoring to include scrutiny of missed skills/knowledge.
