Hello everyone. Welcome to the first Newsletter of Year 2. This is where we will share information about our learning each week.

Maths

Learning activities have focused on place value; understanding the value of tens and ones in two digit numbers; counting amounts to 100 and reading and writing numbers in numerals and words.

English

We have enjoyed reading the story The Jolly Postman by Allan and Janet Ahlberg. Using story maps they have written the children retold the story to help them with their written work. We have composed and written statement and question sentences.

Science

We started by thinking about the job of a scientist and what a scientist does. Then we learned the story of Jane Goodall, a scientist in primatology and how her dreams of being a scientist came true.

We have also spent some time talking with the children about Queen Elizabeth II and thinking about her life. This followed a whole school Worship celebrating the life of Queen Elizabeth.

Homework

Today the children have brought home their maths and reading comprehension homework. There is information for parents on the inside cover and tasks have been stuck into the book. Further information about the homework rota is found in the Parent Handbook.
