Spring Term: Week 5 beginning 30th January

The children have worked extremely hard this week in all areas.

English- We started the week off by having a grammar focus then returned to our work on Macbeth. The children will be writing Macbeth's diary next week, re-telling the main events and getting across the emotions he went through at each point of the story.

Maths- This week in maths, we have focussed on ratio. We looked closely at the wording of questions and worked on the ratios between given numbers.
