Race for Life

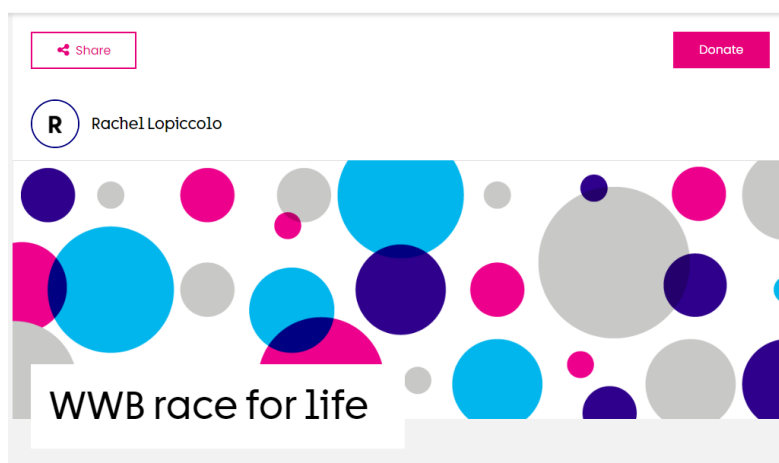
